# Preparing for Layout Builder



# Preparing your site for moving to Layout Builder

## Content Audit & Review

- Audit - List current website pages in a spreadsheet by menu section
  - This will give you a visual overview of how your site is structured.
    - *Be sure to audit your Drupal Admin back end for unpublished pages that can be removed/deleted!*
- Review - Visit each page and review content
  - Identify key pages & content types
  - Locate content that is outdated, duplicated, needs further review, consolidation etc.
  - Find content gaps - what might be missing?
  - Identify commonly used page components (i.e. Cards, Carousels, Accordions, Ping Pongs, etc.)

# Preparing your site for moving to Layout Builder

## Plan your Migration

- Familiarize yourself with [new Layout Builder Components](#)
- Get organized - Write new content, complete audit spreadsheet, identify components you will need
- Identify key pages - start with your home page and important top-level pages
  - Programs, Locations (Branches, Camps, etc.), Memberships, Articles/Blogs, Events, Schedules, etc.
- Create a plan - decide which pages you want to build first
  - Most → Least complex

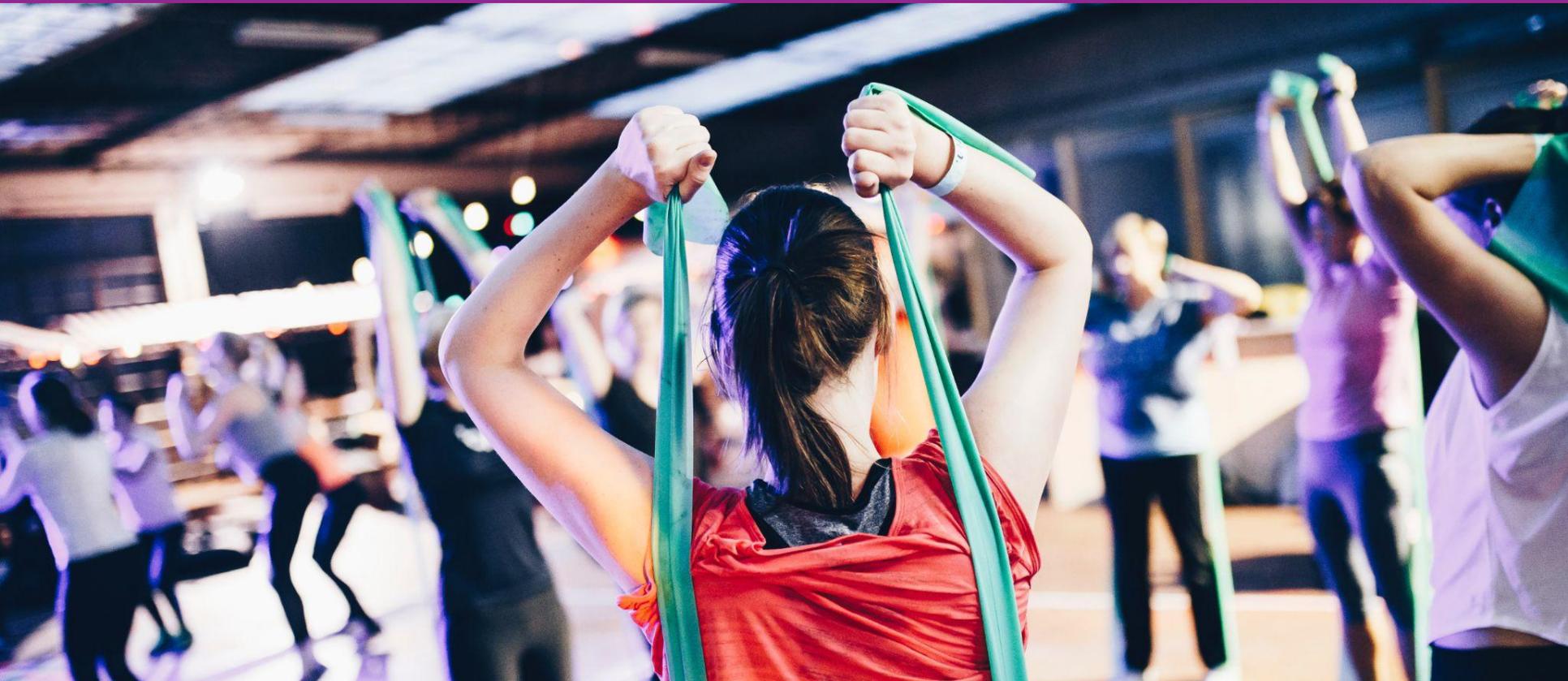

# Design System Release Schedule

- **Version 1** - June
  - Colorway selection for Landing Page Content Type and related components
  - Card and Banner variations
- **Version 2** - September
  - Colorway selection for Branch, Camp, Facility Content Types and related components
  - Colorway selection Article & Event Content Types and related components
  - Style variations for borders, buttons, etc
- **Version 3** - December
  - Canadian Colorway

## Google Analytics 4 - What you need to know

The end of Universal Analytics is coming July 1, 2023.

This is a great time to evaluate how you have used Google Analytics and how you would like to use GA4!

- Set up parallel tracking while you explore GA4
- Review (and archive) Google Universal data that's most important to you
- Configure GA4 to meet your ongoing marketing needs

- One place to add GA code
- No Drupal code changes
- Update tracking in GTM, not in Drupal
